

REMEDIES FOR DOGS LIVING WITH BITCHES IN SEASON



Anatherum

Wants to drink but won't. Sexual appetite increased by every attempt to satisfy it. Involuntary urination during sleep, or while walking. He will be totally intent on mating the bitch, to the point of masturbation and distraction.

Conium

Anxious and dejected. A want to be alone but wants company too. When urinating the flow starts and stops. He's better for sitting still (may sit at the door waiting for it to open) May not want to lie down. Dogs who are rigid of fiber and are easily excited. Everything is "mine as of right" (The dog that owns you!). Generally his symptoms will be worse at night. Indifferent to food may eat but be uncomfortable later. Doesn't want to be touched. He's a dog that desires sunlight and warmth. He may have trembling and shaking of limbs, or jerking of limbs or restlessness of limbs.

Lycopodium

Normally a dog that will be your "little puppy" but will dominate any other dog, or person he thinks is inferior to him. Depressed, anxious, and doesn't want to be alone. He can also be extremely sensitive and apprehensive to every noise, or event. He will be either easily excited with an erection or lack interest entirely and look depressed. He can have premature ejaculation, or an erection with a flow of prostatic fluid. Will eat only a little and walk away, or eat little and often if food is left out. He will be worse between 4pm and 8pm, and will appear more relaxed and happy if moving around, outside in the cool.

Nat Mur

Reserved and "proper": dogs. Happy to be alone and doesn't care for a lot of company. Needs to urinate hourly and passes a lot of urine. Like to sit outside in the fresh air but not in the sunshine. Doesn't like heat very much. Loves or hates the seaside. Generally he will be worse between 10 and 11 in the morning. He will have a loss of appetite. He may suffer abundant hair loss at this time. He can become emaciated even if he eats well. Loves salty things to eat.

Phosphorus

He will show great indifference to everything as well as their own family. Normally an outgoing, friendly dog, the sort of dog who just loves to be the centre of attention. He will have hair Loss and or weight loss. He 's a dog who drinks a lot. Also urinates a lot. He will have a ravenous appetite, and be hungry even after eating. Generally better for company, reassurance, being rubbed. Frequent involuntary loss of semen while around the bitch.

Platina

Arrogant and proud with total contempt for all other dogs. Impulses to kill. He will attack other dogs with intent to kill or maim. Unnaturally increased sexual desire. (Sometimes common in a dog that has been used for stud purposes a lot, or used for stud frequently over a short period). Frequent erections especially at night, with a flow of prostatic fluid. Generally he will be worse in the evenings. He will feel better if walking around, so he may wander around a lot.

Staphysagria

A dog with sweetness of nature. He will have anxiety and agitation, which allow no rest. Hair falls out. His appetite will be normal. He gets colic after upsets. He can have colic with the urge to urinate. Frequent need to urinate especially at night. He may have a constant desire to urinate but may pass very little urine. Discharge of prostatic fluid during bowel motion. Very itchy scrotum will bite and lick at it. Seminal emissions cause great, chagrin, and mortification. He may seem tired in the morning, with stiffness on getting out of bed. Generally better for sitting or lying around, but worse for anger, grief, or mortification especially if they caused the offence

NOTES

These remedies will not sedate your dog. The purpose of this pack is to make your dog(s) more comfortable during the time your bitch(es) are in season.

Some dogs become acutely distressed when bitches are on season, this pack will help them be less distressed. It will not act as a contraceptive nor will it act as a means to completely take away sexual desire in the dog.

You will still need to keep the bitch and dog separated unless you wish a mating to take place.

What you can expect is for your dog to be less intense in his desire to mate your bitch, (rather like how he is prior to her 10-12th day) also to loose less weight, make less noise, eat better and still retain a lot of his coat. In other words, your dog will be less focused on mating your bitch and more his old self.

Dosage - You can start treatment at any time you wish. Preferably on the bitch's 10th day. Select the remedy that is closest to your dog's personality when your bitch is in season.

Give three tablets over the first 24 hours (in a piece of meat or cheese etc), and then give one tablet daily until the dog is more settled in himself or the tablets have all gone.

Should an accidental mating take place, contact your vet urgently for a morning after injection.

HANDLING AND STORAGE OF REMEDIES.

Store remedies away from strong light, strong smells or odours.
Remove tablets from the bags with a spoon and handle as little as possible.
